## HOW TO GET HERE

By car: Travel north on I5 to Washington border exit 275 (also known as the “truck crossing”). Proceed north to Canada’s Hwy. 1 (Trans-Canada Hwy.) Take Hwy. 1 westbound and follow signs towards Vancouver. Continue on Hwy. 1 through West Vancouver and follow signs to Horseshoe Bay ferry. (Bowen Island ferry tollbooth is on the far right hand side.) The trip takes about 20 min. Drive up the hill through the village. Near the top of the hill, veer right onto Mt. Gardner Road. (There is a school on the right side at that intersection.) Follow Mt. Gardner Road until just past the recycling depot. Turn left onto the gravel road — there’s a small wooden Camp Bow-Isle sign at the entrance. If you get lost call (604) 947-2500.
